WILDERNESS SCHOOL COMMUNITY ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

The Wilderness School Community Entrance Scholarship was established in 2021 by Wilderness School's current and past parent, old scholar, student and donor communities, and other friends of the School, to open a doorway to a brand new future to a girl who would otherwise be unable to attend a school like Wilderness.

Our generous community enables and supports this crowd-funded scholarship through philanthropic contributions to the Wilderness School Foundation Scholarship Fund.

PURPOSE

The Wilderness School Community Entrance Scholarship is a five-year fixed-term scholarship offered to a girl entering Year 8, providing 100% fee remission from Years 8 through 12. The Scholarship will be offered to a deserving girl with an excellent academic record who would receive the greatest benefit from this opportunity.

The purpose of the Wilderness School Foundation Scholarship Fund is to nurture and extend the recipient with an exceptional education which will set her on a path to flourish in her personal and professional life.

PREREQUISITES

- The applicant must not be a current student of Wilderness School.
- The applicant's Care Giver/s will be required to demonstrate evidence of their financial position, which would otherwise inhibit them from applying to Wilderness School.
- The applicant will complete the Application Form in full with the required attached documentation.
- The applicant must demonstrate an excellent academic record.

APPLICATION PROCESS AND SELECTION CRITERIA

- Applications will be open and publicly advertised in 2022 with the Scholarship awarded in 2023 for Year 8 commencement in 2024.
- Potential candidates will be selected on the basis of their written application, interview process, academic record and financial considerations.
- Academic testing may be a part of this process. Selection considerations will include which candidate is most likely to benefit from this Scholarship and which candidate would be otherwise precluded for financial reasons.
- After consideration of applications, short-listed candidates will be interviewed.
- The Community Entrance Scholarship will be awarded to the candidate who is considered the most deserving and who would receive the greatest benefit.
- The successful applicant will be advised in writing during Term 1 of the year preceding the commencement of the scholarship and will receive the required documentation from our Academic Registrar.

Applications open: August 2022.

Closing Date for Applications: Friday 27 January 2023.

SCHOLARSHIP ENTITLEMENTS AND OBLIGATIONS

- The Community Entrance Scholarship provides 100% fee remission for a day student, enrolment fees, application fees, and the consolidated fixed charge for five years inclusive of Years 8-12.
- If awarded the scholarship, the recipient will acknowledge the generosity of the Wilderness School Foundation Scholarship Fund in writing.
- On occasion, the recipient may be required to share their experiences by being interviewed for publications or by public speaking at donor events.

The scholarship does not cover:

- Travel to and from Wilderness School
- Discretionary activities like, but not limited to, individual music tuition and overseas trips
- Books and stationery
- Uniform, shoes, school bag.

NOTE: The Wilderness School Foundation is not required to award the scholarship if it is deemed that no applicants meet the criteria.

The Wilderness School Principal is authorised to rescind the scholarship if achievements or behaviour are deemed inappropriate or poor. Failure to meet payment within payment terms of the excluded items above will result in a review of the scholarship offering. The terms and conditions of enrolment for the School will apply to the enrolment.
