AN OUTSTANDING YEAR OF ACHIEVEMENT

The Class of 2025 has delivered an outstanding set of results that firmly place Wilderness School as the top-performing school by ATAR in South Australia in 2025.

This year, 95 girls applied for the ATAR. With a median ATAR of 96.7 and first place in every key performance category, including 99+, 95+ and 90+ ATARs, their results reflect academic excellence at the very highest level.

Behind these numbers is a cohort of young women who approached their studies with purpose, curiosity and determination, learning in an environment shaped by thoughtful teaching, high expectations and genuine care. Together, they demonstrate what is possible when girls are supported to aim high and are believed in at every step.

These are exceptional results. I am incredibly proud of our Year 12 girls, and the wonderful teachers who challenge, support and inspire our students every day. I congratulate everyone in our community on another extraordinary year.

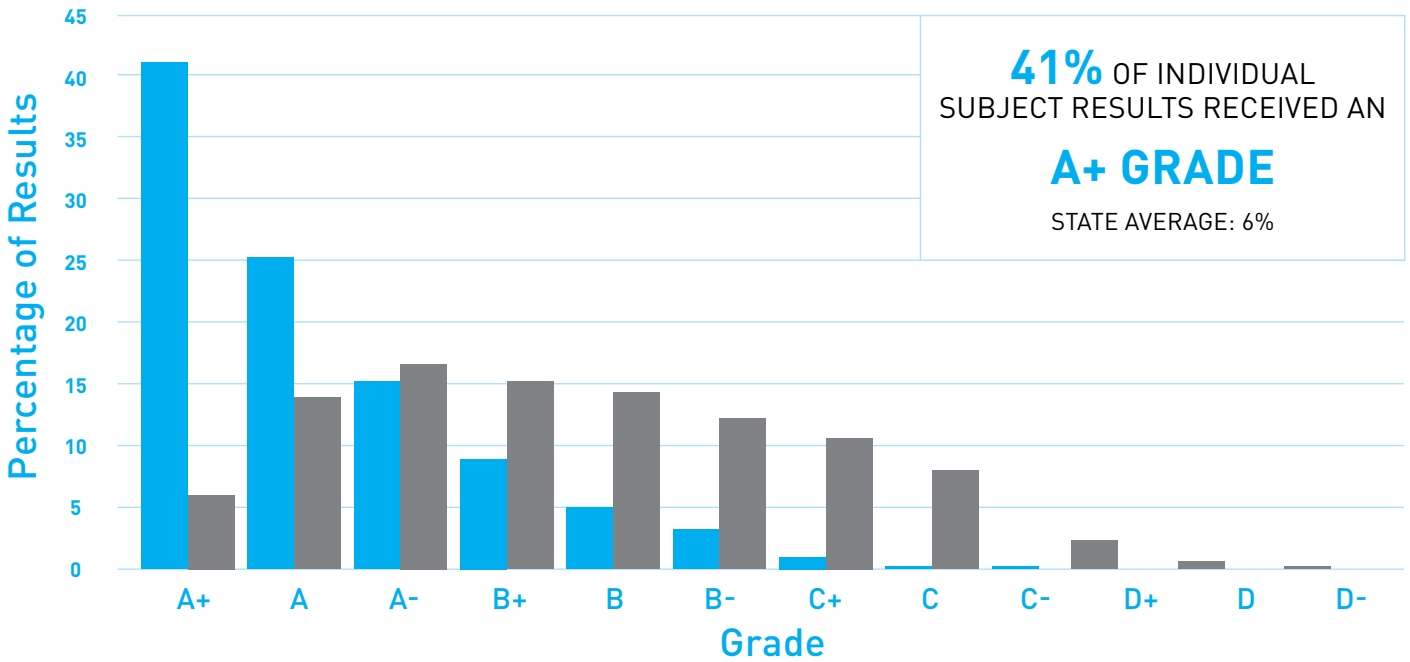

These exceptional results matter because of the opportunities they create. They give girls the confidence to follow their passions and open doors to diverse and meaningful futures.

Of the cohort, 81% of students received a university offer to their first-preference degree. They are pursuing studies across more than 30 fields, from architecture and the creative arts to business, law, engineering, education, health, medicine, psychology and science, and have accepted offers from 12 universities across Australia and internationally. The majority (73%) are attending Adelaide University.

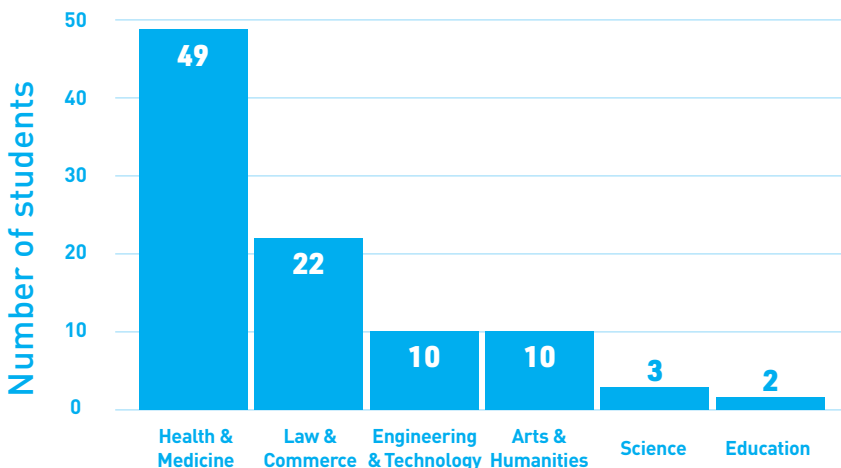

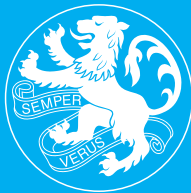
