New Students

All new students will be invited to make an appointment for a uniform fitting in November, or prior to commencement.

Boarders

Boarders can purchase items from the Uniform Shop on account. Itemised accounts from the Uniform Shop will be emailed to parents on a monthly basis and are separate from your School fees account.

- Payment of Uniform Shop account is 30 days; the shop accepts Visa Card, MasterCard and direct deposit. Details are included on your monthly statement.
- If desired, parents may determine a financial limit for their daughter's account. Please discuss this with the Uniform Shop Manager.
- Parents may also choose to leave credit card details with the Uniform Shop for payment of uniform purchases. These details are stored in the safe.
- Accounts more than 60 days overdue will attract a fee of \$20. No account purchases may be made while an account is overdue.
- The Uniform Shop is unable to offer credit if accounts remain outstanding for 90 days or more.

Uniform Information

Early Learning

Uniform is compulsory for all girls in the Mamie House (3-year-olds) and Annie House (4-year-olds).

The uniform described below is also worn as the PE uniform for Reception and Year 1.

Summer (Terms 1 and 4)

- Grey PE shorts with white crest
- Blue short sleeve polo shirt with grey piping
- Wilderness Rugby jumper
- Blue sun hat
- Dark brown school sandals (worn without socks) or
- Predominantly white joggers (no brightly coloured trim or glitter)
- Wilderness PE socks or plain white socks

Winter (Terms 2 and 3)

- Blue long sleeve polo shirt with grey piping
- Wilderness grey track pants with white crest
- Rugby jumper
- Softshell jacket (optional)

- Plain white skivvy ELC only (optional)
- Predominantly white joggers (no brightly coloured trim or glitter)
- Wilderness PE socks or plain white socks

Other Items

- Small Wilderness back pack or own small back pack
- Library bag (also needed for Reception to Year 2)
- Hair should be tied back with hair coloured elastics and ribbon should be white or blue (available from the Uniform Shop)

Please note:

ELC uniform should not be worn with casual clothes.

All uniform with the exception of skivvy, shoes and sandals is available from the Wilderness Uniform Shop unless otherwise stated.

Reception to Year 2

In general, summer uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4, and winter uniform during Terms 2 and 3.

Girls may choose to wear their summer or winter uniform in the first 2 weeks of Term 2 and 4 and the last 2 weeks of Term 1 and Term 3.

Summer (Terms 1 and 4)

- Wilderness checked summer dress, worn at knee length or longer
- White summer hat
- Blue sun hat
- Brown jumper (plain)
- Dark brown sandals (worn without socks) or
- Black Mary Jane style school shoes preferably with velcro fastening
- Knee or ankle length white socks
- Blue, white or uniform fabric hair accessories

Winter (Terms 2 and 3)

- Brown Wilderness raincoat (worn to and from School with winter uniform)
- Blue Peter Pan blouse
- Pinafore, worn at knee length or longer or Wilderness taupe trousers
- Striped button-on tab tie
- Brown jumper (plain)
- Black Mary Jane style school shoes preferably with velcro fastening
- Knee length chocolate brown socks or chocolate brown tights
- Brown, blue or uniform fabric hair accessories
- Wilderness blazer (optional)
- Brown scarf and brown gloves (optional)

Physical Education

Year 2 is the transition year from blue PE polo shirt to white PE polo shirt. The blue polo shirt may be worn in Year 2 until your daughter outgrows it.

- Blue short sleeve or long sleeve (winter only) polo shirt with grey piping. (ELC-Year 2)
- White short sleeve polo shirt with grey piping. (Year 2 to Year 12)
- Grey PE shorts with white crest
- Grey track pants with white crest
- Wilderness rugby jumper
- Blue sun hat or blue 'Wildy' PE cap
- Wilderness striped PE ankle socks or plain white ankle socks
- Predominantly white track shoes
- Wilderness blue PE bag (optional)
- Wilderness softshell jacket (optional)

All uniform with the exception of shoes and sandals are available from the Wilderness Uniform Shop unless otherwise stated.

Years 3 to Year 6

In general, summer uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4, and winter uniform during Terms 2 and 3.

Girls may choose to wear their summer or winter uniform in the first 2 weeks of Term 2 and 4 and the last 2 weeks of Term 1 and Term 3.

Summer (Terms 1 and 4)

- Wilderness checked summer dress, worn at knee length or longer
- White summer hat
- Plain brown jumper (cable jumper may be worn in Year 6 and becomes compulsory in Year 7)
- Blue sun hat
- Dark brown sandals (worn without socks) or
- Black traditional lace up school shoes (no contrast stitching)
- Knee or ankle length white socks
- Blue, white or uniform fabric hair accessories, available from the Uniform Shop

Winter (Terms 2 and 3)

Year 3 is the transition year from pinafore and Peter Pan blouse to skirt and overblouse, either is acceptable. New students in Year 3 will go straight into a skirt and overblouse.

- Wilderness blazer (worn to and from School with winter uniform)
- Blue over blouse (required from Year 4)
- Crossover tie (required from Year 4)
- Wilderness standard tie (optional, Years 4 to 6)

- Winter skirt, worn at knee length or longer (required from Year 4) or Wilderness taupe trousers
- Blue, brown, or uniform fabric hair accessories, available from the Uniform Shop
- Black lace up traditional school shoes (no contrast stitching)
- Knee length chocolate brown socks or chocolate brown tights
- Plain brown jumper

Physical Education

- White polo shirt with grey piping
- Grey shorts with white crest
- Blue sun hat or blue 'Wildy' PE cap
- Wilderness striped PE ankle socks or plain white ankle socks
- Wilderness grey track pants with white crest

Years 7 to Year 12

In general, summer uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4, and winter uniform during Terms 2 and 3.

Girls may choose to wear their summer or winter uniform in the first 2 weeks of Term 2 and 4 and the last 2 weeks of Term 1 and Term 3.

Summer (Terms 1 and 4)

- Wilderness Blazer
- Wilderness checked summer dress, worn at knee length or longer
- White summer hat
- Brown cable jumper
- Black traditional lace-up school shoes (no contrast stitching)
- Knee or ankle length white socks
- Blue, white or uniform fabric hair accessories, available from the Uniform Shop

Winter (Terms 2 and 3)

- Wilderness blazer (worn to and from School every day with winter uniform)
- Blue over blouse
- Winter skirt, worn at knee length or longer or Wilderness taupe trousers
- Wilderness standard tie
- Brown cable jumper
- Knee length chocolate brown socks or chocolate brown tights
- Black traditional lace up school shoes (no contrast stitching)
- Blue, brown or uniform fabric hair accessories, available from the Uniform Shop

Physical Education

- White polo shirt with grey piping
- Grey shorts with white crest

Competition Sport Uniform

Girls who choose to participate in interschool sport are required to purchase a sport uniform. With the exception of netball, rowing and water polo, summer sport uniforms need to be ordered in Terms 3 or 4 and winter sport uniforms are ordered early in Term 1.

All uniform with the exception of shoes and sandals is available from the Wilderness Uniform Shop unless otherwise stated.

Uniform Code

School uniform is compulsory at Wilderness School and all students are expected to take pride in their appearance and grooming.

The correct uniform is to be worn in its entirety to and from School. No additional items are to be worn at any time during the School day. All uniform items are expected to be named and in good condition.

In general, summer uniform is worn during Terms 1 and 4 and winter uniform during Terms 2 and 3.

Girls may choose to wear their summer or winter uniform in the first two weeks of Term 2 and Term4 and the last two weeks of Term 1 and Term 3.

Uniform

The length of the summer dress, winter skirt and pinafore must be at the knee or longer. Girls will be required to lengthen or replace their uniform with one of correct length if it is too short.

Summer Uniform

Summer dress, white hat and black school shoes with long or short white socks (Reception to Year 12), or dark brown sandals (Reception to Year 6). The Wilderness blazer (Years 3 to 12) is optional in summer unless required for a School excursion or other formal occasion. Girls in Reception to Year 2 do not require a blazer.

Winter Uniform

Reception to Year 2: Pinafore, Peter Pan blouse, tab tie, plain brown jumper and black Mary Jane style school shoes with dark brown socks or tights.

Years 3 to 6: Wilderness blazer, skirt, plain brown jumper, over blouse and crossover tie. Year 3 is the transition year from pinafore and Peter Pan blouse to the skirt and over blouse, either is acceptable.

Years 7 to 12: Wilderness blazer, skirt, cable jumper, over blouse and regular tie.

Formal occasions/excursions

Girls are expected to wear the full School uniform, including the Wilderness blazer with shoes (not sandals) and long socks (not tights) when representing the School at formal occasions.

Crossover ties (Years 3 to 6) must be worn on all formal occasions during winter. On formal occasions the jumper is not worn under the blazer. Excursions are viewed as a formal occasion.

Girls will not be allowed to attend excursions unless the correct uniform is worn. Long socks should be pulled up.

Blazer

Wilderness blazer (Years 3 to 12) is optional in summer unless required for a School excursion or other formal occasion. The School blazer must always be worn to and from School with winter uniform, on School excursions and formal occasions.

Raincoats

The brown Wilderness raincoat is compulsory for Reception to Year 2 students and optional for Years 3 to 6 students. It may be worn instead of the blazer during wet weather for Years 3 to 6.

Jumper

The plain brown and brown cable jumpers are worn all year round. The jumper may not be worn as the outer garment to and from School, but may be worn under the blazer. However, on formal occasions, the jumper is not worn under the blazer. The jumper may be worn as the outer garment within the School grounds.

The plain jumper is worn from Reception to Year 6. The cable jumper is worn from Years 7 to 12. Year 6 is a transition period from plain jumper to a cable jumper. Girls in year 6 may wear the cable jumper if they out grow their plain jumper.

Pinafore or Skirt (Year 3)

Generally, girls in Year 3 wear the pinafore until the end of Term 3 of that year. However, if she outgrows her pinafore, needs to pass it on to a younger sibling or is a new student to the School, a skirt with over blouse and crossover tie may be worn. The skirt, over blouse and crossover tie are worn from Year 4. The Peter Pan blouse is worn with the pinafore only, and not worn with the skirt.

Tie

The fabric tab tie is worn with the Peter Pan blouse and pinafore from Reception to the end of Year 3. Cross-over ties are worn with the skirt and over blouse to Year 6. The standard tie may be worn as an alternative to the cross-over tie with the skirt and over blouse. Standard ties are worn for Years 7 to 12 with winter uniform. Year 12 girls may wear the Year 12 tie as an alternative to the brown standard tie.

Hats

The white summer hat must be worn to and from School with the summer uniform and on excursions during summer. Girls in ELC to Year 6 are expected to wear the blue sun hat during play periods and blue sun hat or blue 'Wildy' PE cap during PE lessons. Our policy is 'No Hat, No Play' for all girls in the junior School. Girls will be asked to sit in the shade if they do not wear their hat. Girls in Year 7-12 are required to wear the 'Wildy' PE cap during Physical Education or sport.

Head Scarves and Special Uniform Requirements

A Head scarf may be worn if it is required for religious reasons. Head scarves worn with summer uniform must be in either Wilderness Blue or White; and head scarves worn with winter uniform, must be Wilderness blue or dark brown. Please speak to the Uniform Shop Manager for further details.

Students wearing headscarves must wear the official school sunhat (R-Year 6) over their head scarf when outdoors during Term 1 and 4, or the Wilderness cap as required during PE or Sport (Years 7 to 12).

If girls wish to cover their legs in summer, Wilderness grey leggings may be worn for PE lessons and for sport matches. Wilderness leggings are available from the Uniform Shop on request.

Please discuss any other special uniform requirements with the Uniform Shop Manager.

Long-Sleeved Alternatives

Requests for the checked long-sleeved alternative summer dress or white polo shirt must be made in writing to the Principal, outlining the exceptional circumstances for consideration and approval. The checked long-sleeve summer dress and polo incurs additional costs and time frames which will be confirmed by the Uniform Shop Manager.

PE Uniform

All girls from Reception to Year 10 attend PE lessons. Girls in Years 11 and 12 will not require a PE uniform unless they are participating in competition sport or studying SACE PE.

Junior School girls wear their PE uniform to school all day on the days they have PE lessons.

Middle and Senior School girls may not arrive at school or leave school at the end of the day in PE uniform except when they have sport practice before or after School. If girls have PE after recess and sport practice after School they may change into their PE uniform at recess and remain in their sport uniform for the rest of the day.

Whole School Events

All girls in Years 3 to 12 require bathers for Swimming Carnival. A House polo is also required for Swimming Carnival, Sports Day and Cross Country.

School Bags

Wilderness School bags are compulsory. The Uniform Shop stocks back packs in three sizes and one size trolley bag.

School sport bags are also available but not compulsory.

Commemorative Tops

Tops that have been designed for a School trip or sporting event, for example, are not to be worn beyond the particular event for which they were designed.

Year 12

The cream Year 12 jumper may be worn at any time with the formal School uniform as an alternative to the brown jumper. Year 12 'hoodies' may be worn at School only with agreement from the Principal. These tops may not be worn to and from School or outside the School at any time with School uniform. They must not be worn to PE lessons or to sport practices. However, they may be worn with casual clothes at any time.

Hair

Hair below the collar in length should be tied back. Hair styles must be kept simple and tidy and should be age appropriate. Whilst the School recognises that hairstyles are a matter of individual style and taste, all students are required to keep their hair neat and clean and unobtrusive (e.g., no dreadlocks).

Hair accessories for winter uniform are blue, brown or uniform fabric, and for summer uniform, blue, white or uniform fabric. Hair coloured elastics or combs are acceptable. A wide range of hair accessories is available from the Uniform Shop. Hair colouring is not acceptable for primary aged students. Hair colouring, if used by older students, should be natural looking and subtle, i.e., no more than two (2) shades different from its natural colour.

Jewellery/Cosmetics/Tattoos

Jewellery: No jewellery is to be worn with School uniform. However, one pair (one in each ear lobe) of plain silver, gold or pearl studs no larger than 5mm in diameter or standard size sleepers are permitted. Body Piercing is not permitted. Watches are encouraged and must be plain with a silver/gold or neutral band.

Makeup (including, but not limited to, blush, eyeliner, eye shadow, foundation, lipstick, and mascara) is not permitted. On written advice from a medical practitioner, a student will be allowed to wear a light covering of prescribed foundation that matches her skin tone.

Nail Polish: Coloured nail polish is not permitted.

Tattoos: Permanent and temporary tattoos are not permitted.

Smoking and the chewing of gum are forbidden at School, and in School uniform.

Cycling to School

Girls cycling to School must wear an approved safety helmet. A girl cycling to School will be excused from wearing her blazer but will require a parental note in her diary, to be signed by her Head of School. If there is an excursion she will be required to bring her blazer.

Naming your Uniform

It is a requirement of the school that all uniform items are clearly named. Iron-on labels, stitched on labels and permanent marker are all acceptable.

Interschool Sport Uniform

Junior School

Girls up to Year 6 wear their PE uniform for all training and matches.

Years 7 to 12

All girls who play competition sport at Wilderness require a separate sport uniform. Every girl will be allocated a number that she will use across all sports she plays at Wilderness, from Year 7 to Year 12. All girls will retain the same number across all sports through to Year 12.

Summer Sports

Orders for most summer sport uniforms are taken during Term 3 and Term 4. Rowing and water polo uniforms do not need to be ordered and are available from the Uniform Shop during the season.

- Touch Football Wilderness sport singlet, Wilderness grey PE shorts or Wilderness grey bike shorts and Wilderness white PE socks
- **Tennis** Wilderness sport T shirt, Wilderness grey PE shorts and Wilderness white PE socks
- **Volleyball** Wilderness sport singlet, Wilderness grey PE shorts and Wilderness white PE socks
- **Basketball** Wilderness sport singlet, basketball shorts and Wilderness white PE socks
- **Rowing** Wilderness zoot suit and compression top, Wilderness pink visor and Wilderness cap
- Water Polo Wilderness water polo bathers. Wilderness PE polo and Wilderness grey PE shorts should be worn to training and matches.

Winter Sports

Orders for most winter sport uniforms will be taken early in Term 1. Netball dresses do not need to be ordered and are available from the uniform shop during the season.

- **AFL** Wilderness AFL guernsey, AFL shorts and long blue socks
- Netball Wilderness netball dress and Wilderness white PE socks
- **Soccer** Wilderness sport T shirt, Wilderness grey PE shorts and long blue socks
- **Hockey** Wilderness sport singlet, Wilderness grey PE shorts and long blue socks
- Lacrosse Wilderness sport T shirt and Wilderness grey PE shorts, Wilderness white PE socks.
- **Badminton** Wilderness sport T shirt, Wilderness grey PE shorts and Wilderness white PE socks.

Girls should wear Wilderness PE track pants, rugby jumper and/or softshell jacket for warm-up and cool down activities, no other items are acceptable. Long blue socks and white PE socks may be purchased from the Uniform Shop.

Girls may not play interschool sport matches in track pants, rugby jumper or softshell jacket. If a girl needs to cover her legs for religious reasons, grey leggings may be purchased from the Uniform Shop upon request.

Sale of Second Hand Uniform*

Second Hand Uniform is accepted on a consignment basis and is processed four times per year.

Condition of uniforms: Only clothing in good condition should be brought to the Uniform Shop for sale. Please ensure that **all garments** are *freshly laundered*, and blazers, skirts and pinafores are *dry-cleaned*. We will not accept any garments that are very thin, frayed, worn or with stains, tears, holes or obvious repairs needed.

Second Hand Uniform form: The Second Hand Uniform form can be downloaded from the Parent Portal, collected from the Uniform Shop or you can contact the Uniform Shop and one can be emailed to you. Please complete the *Second Hand Uniform form* with your signature and date, and leave it with the garments you would like us to sell for you.

Pricing: Uniform Shop staff will determine a selling price for all goods. The Uniform Shop Manager reserves the right to dispose of any garments considered unsuitable for sale. Second Hand garments may be left at the Uniform Shop or at the School's Front Office.

We do not accept the following:

- Numbered sport tops
- Shoes, socks, tights or bike shorts
- Discontinued Fleece Jackets
- Discontinued Spray Jackets
- Discontinued PE skirts
- Nova branded bathers with blue crest
- 'Scuttle' or 'Scuttle by Marie Brereton' labelled dresses, skirts, pinafores and blazers.

Receiving stock: The Uniform Shop accepts summer uniform from Week 5, Term 3 until Week 5, Term 1. Winter uniform is accepted from Week 5, Term 1 until Week 5, Term 3. PE uniform, ELC uniform, blazers and jumpers are accepted at all times. Second Hand uniforms may be left at the Uniform Shop or at the School's Front Office. Families who have left or are leaving the School may bring second hand uniform in at any time throughout the year.

Payment: Second Hand Uniform is accepted on a consignment basis and is processed four times per year. Once goods are sold, 60% of the selling price will be credited to school fees accounts for current families. Former families will receive a direct deposit into their nominated bank account.
