After consideration of applications, potential candidates will be interviewed by a member of the academic staff and a member of the Old Scholars' Association Committee.

The successful candidate will receive a remission of 50% of the tuition fees for each year of their senior school years (Years 10, 11 and 12).

Please note that for candidates to be considered for a scholarship, an Application of Enrolment Form needs to be submitted, or have previously been submitted, on their behalf.

- A brief essay by the student (no more than 500 words) explaining why she would like to win a scholarship to Wilderness School
- A letter from the parent/guardian commenting on 'why Wilderness'
- Two written character references with one from your current Principal or a teacher
- \bigcirc A 10cm x 15cm photo of the student.
