Boarding Entrance *Scholarship*

YEAR 7–11, 2028

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A limited number of Boarding Entrance Scholarships are available to new students applying for entry to Years 7 to 11 in 2028.

These scholarships are awarded to students who have demonstrated a commitment to making a positive contribution to their school and/or local community.

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

Selection Criteria

Selection will be based on:

- Overall academic performance and future potential
(*Academic testing may form part of the selection process*)
- Achievement and involvement in areas of excellence such as the performing arts, visual arts, sport, music, debating and other relevant pursuits
- Citizenship, including community service
- Leadership qualities

Following consideration of applications, shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend an interview with a panel of School representatives, including the Head of Boarding. Interviews will be scheduled by the Enrolments Office throughout 2026.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be enrolled in Years 5 to 9 at another school in 2026 and be seeking entry into Years 7 to 11 at Wilderness in 2028.
- Applicants must not be current students at Wilderness or have accepted an offer of enrolment at Wilderness.
- Candidates must be Australian citizens or permanent residents or hold a valid Australian visa that permits enrolment at Wilderness School. Students studying on an Overseas Student (subclass 500) visa are not eligible to apply.

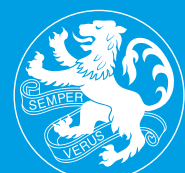

Boarding Entrance Scholarship

Please note: Applications should be submitted in an A4 display folder containing no more than 10 plastic sleeves.

- ☐ Completed Scholarship Application Form
- ☐ Payment of the non-refundable \$100 Application for Enrolment fee (*if an Application for Enrolment has not previously been submitted on the applicant's behalf*)
- ☐ Copies of the student's two most recent school reports
- ☐ Most recent NAPLAN results
- ☐ Copies of any relevant academic, sporting, music, artistic or community awards and/or results
- ☐ Copy of the applicant's birth certificate or passport
- ☐ A brief essay by the student (maximum 300 words) explaining why they would like to be considered for a scholarship at Wilderness School
- ☐ Two written character references, including one from the student's current Principal or a teacher
- ☐ One 10 cm × 15 cm photograph of the student

Further information

- Successful applicants must commence at Wilderness School in Years 7 to 11 in 2028.
- The scholarship provides up to 50% remission of tuition fees (excluding other charges and extras) for the duration of the enrolment, subject to the ongoing terms and conditions of the scholarship.
- The scholarship does not cover the cost of books, stationery, educational excursions or trips and subject charges. All other fees and charges remain payable.
- The award of the scholarship shall be at the absolute discretion of the Council of Governors.
- If a scholarship recipient fails to attend regularly or receives an unsatisfactory report relating to conduct or diligence, the Council of Governors may, at its discretion, withdraw the scholarship.
- The Council of Governors reserves the right not to award a scholarship if no suitable applications are received.

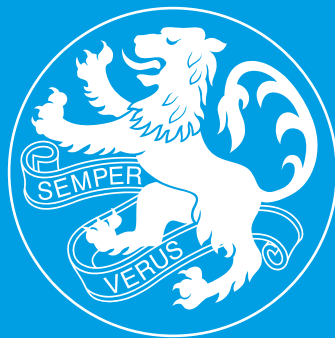
