Academic Entrance *Scholarship*

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A limited number of Academic Entrance Scholarships are offered to new students applying to Wilderness for entry into Year 8, 10 and 11 in 2027.

Applicants will be required to sit an AAS examination and, if shortlisted, attend an interview.

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP

Checklist:

- ☐ Applications must be completed **online** via AAS before the closing date.
- ☐ Applications close at 11.30 pm ACDT on Monday 31 August 2026. No late registrations will be accepted.

- ☐ Follow the prompts to complete your registration. Payment of the non-refundable \$150 registration fee must be made online.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be enrolled in Years 7, 9 or 10 at another school in 2026 and be seeking entry into Years 8, 10 or 11 at Wilderness in 2027.
- Applicants must not be current students at Wilderness or have accepted an offer of enrolment at Wilderness.
- Candidates must be Australian citizens or permanent residents or hold a valid Australian visa that permits enrolment at Wilderness School. Students studying on an Overseas Student (subclass 500) visa are not eligible to apply.

Academic Entrance *Scholarship*

Application process

At the time of registration, applicants must upload the following documents:

- Copies of the applicant's two most recent school reports
- Most recent NAPLAN results
- Copies of any relevant academic, sporting, music, artistic or community awards or achievements
- Copy of the applicant's birth certificate or passport

Applicants must complete all scholarship application questions, including a brief essay (maximum 300 words) written by the student applicant, outlining why they wish to be considered for an academic scholarship at Wilderness School.

Applications will be assessed based on performance in the AAS Scholarship Examination, supporting documentation and, for shortlisted applicants, an interview.

Shortlisted applicants will be invited to attend an interview based on their performance in the AAS Scholarship Examination. Interviews will commence in the week beginning Monday 14 September 2026.

Families will be advised of the outcome by the end of Term 3, 2026, allowing successful applicants time to prepare for commencement at Wilderness in 2027.

Further information

- Successful applicants must commence at Wilderness School in Years 8, 10 or 11 in 2027.
- The scholarship provides up to 50% remission of tuition fees (excluding other charges and extras) for the duration of the enrolment, subject to the ongoing terms and conditions of the scholarship.
- The scholarship does not cover the cost of books, stationery, educational excursions or trips and subject charges. All other fees and charges remain payable.
- The award of the scholarship shall be at the absolute discretion of the Council of Governors.
- If a scholarship recipient fails to attend regularly or receives an unsatisfactory report relating to conduct or diligence, the Council of Governors may, at its discretion, withdraw the scholarship.
- The Council of Governors reserves the right not to award a scholarship if no suitable applications are received.
- The AAS Scholarship Examination is administered and marked by Academic Assessment Services.

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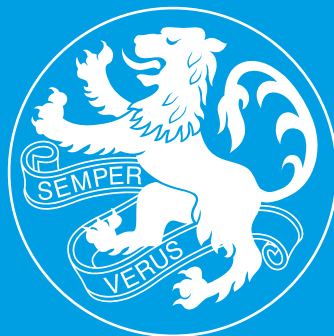
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
