

YEAR 12 RESULTS 2019



Once again our students have achieved excellent results. There were 84 girls who applied for the ATAR this year. Of the cohort 69% were placed in the top 10%, with 56% in the top 5% and 26% in the top 1% of Year 12 students.

The position of Dux was shared by two outstanding students, Akanksha Mahajan and Victoria Moularadellis, who each achieved an ATAR of 99.9.

Victoria Moularadellis was selected for the highest accolade of the SACE, The Governor of South Australia Commendation Excellence Award for outstanding academic achievement, including the development of one or more of the SACE capabilities. The Governor of South Australia presented Victoria's award on the stage as part of the formal SACE Merit Ceremony held on Tuesday 4 February, 2020.


