


YEAR 7-10 MUSIC OPEN AND ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP



YEAR 7-10 MUSIC **OPEN AND ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP 2022**

Music Scholarships are offered to new students applying to Wilderness and to current Wilderness students who will be Year 7-10 in 2022.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

- Candidates will be required to attend an audition and an interview
- Candidates must be of at least Grade 3 AMEB Standard
- Candidates may also be required to attend academic testing

After consideration of applications, short-listed candidates will be interviewed by a panel led by the Head of Music. Interviews will be scheduled in November 2020.

- If required the candidate should provide a piano accompanist.
- Candidates must provide two copies of any scores performed in the audition

Offers will be made to successful candidates by early December 2020.

Scholarship Application Form

Most recent NAPLAN results
Any other relevant academic, sporting, music, artistic, community awards and/or results
A brief essay by the student (no more than 500 words) explaining why you would like to win a scholarship to Wilderness School
Two written character references. One from your current Principal or a teacher
A 10cm x 15cm photo of the student


Please note that for candidates to be considered for a Scholarship, an Application of Enrolment Form needs to be submitted, or have previously been submitted, on their behalf.
